A few key changes are coming for next year, so for those early-bird shoppers and planners, below you'll find supply lists, dress code guidelines, and a few updates to help with your preparations. Be sure to scroll to page 2 for the complete supply list.

Updated School-Wide Policies:

1. FSWC-Lee will follow the Lee County School District and Florida state statute regarding student cell phone use at school. Students must keep their personal wireless communication devices (WCDs), such as cell phones, smartwatches, headphones, and earbuds, turned off and stored during the entire school day from 8:00-2:30. Individual cell phone lockers will be provided.

2. Dress Code: All students are expected to wear approved "standardized dress code" clothing consisting of:

- **THIS IS NEW**: <u>Only</u> collared, polo-style shirts (short or long sleeved) are required for all students. Any color, pattern, or logo is acceptable as long as it is school appropriate.
 - Pants must have no rips or tears above the knee and must be worn at the waist. Yoga and Spandex-type pants and are not allowed.
 - Shorts, dresses, and skirts must be no more than 4 inches above the knee.
 - Students may wear school T-shirts on Fridays, and when appropriate, club T-shirts on Club Days (i.e. Key Club, Science Club, etc.).
 - Shoes should be appropriate for the school setting (i.e. no slides or slippers).
 - Hats are not allowed except for days when outside activities are planned
